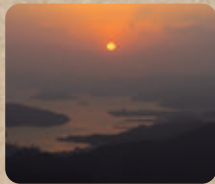




Banjyo Osakanakan & Yayoi Baths

The Banjyo Osakanakan, which is right next to Michi no Eki, keeps about 100 types of fish, most of which are freshwater fish that are native to the Banjyo River! And the Yayoi Baths are fully equipped with "Dead Sea" baths that have 10x the salinity of ocean water.



Mt. Shakuma

A scared mountain that rises 645 m above sea level. It was once venerated as a place for spiritual training. At the top of the mountain is Shakuma Shrine, which worships the god of great fortune and business prosperity. From here, a picturesque scene awaits you—one where you can look out over Saiki Bay and see as far as Shikoku.



Yukagi Dam

This dam was constructed as a dry dam over a period of 12 years and completed in 1985. Ryokuchi Park and the area surrounding the dam are lined with cherry blossom trees.
Type: Concrete gravity dam
Height: 58.5m
Length: 249.0m
Total reservoir capacity: 3,520,000m³



Ginger (processed goods)

This area is engaged in the cultivation of ginger and selling ginger-based processed goods as "Ginger Town Yayoi." Croquettes, rusks, dressing, shortbread, and other products made with ginger are sold at local shops and at Michi no Eki Yayoi.



Seiryu-Banjyo Riverside Course

The basic tour is a riverside course and will not use public roads. Because there are three detour courses, you can enjoy a different course every time. (1) Learn history at the Polished stone tower. (2) At Tsubaki Road, you can enjoy the seasonal changes of nature from autumn leaves to blooming camellia flowers. (3) At Shiki no Mori, you can fully enjoy the twittering of birds from the promenade that runs along the Isaki River. You can also play in the water along the way, so you can even enjoy a leisurely stroll with your children on this course. The basic course has a total length of 2.6 km, while the shortest course is 1.0 km and the longest course is 4.3 km.

Polished stone tower

You can see pagodas that were carved into the face of a mountain from the late Kamakura period to the period of the Northern and Southern Courts in Japanese history.

Duration : Approx. 1.5 hours
Vertical drop : 0 m
(Detour to wooden promenade Approx. 20 m)
Calories burned : Approx. 221 kcal

START & GOAL

Michi no Eki Yayoi

The gateway to Saiki. First, take a break! This spot is fully equipped with parking, restaurants, a freshwater aquarium, and bathing facilities! Agricultural products, seafood, souvenirs and more are also sold here.



1 The Cuddling Trees

These two trees (metasequoia) have cuddled together, standing strong even against floods, and they have always been called "The Cuddling Trees." How about taking a photo here with your special someone?



3 Koda weir

This area is the habitat for sweetfish, freshwater minnow, amur goby, and other similar fish. This is one of the top 5 clear streams in Kyushu. It also has a fishway that is maintained.

2 Kappa Bridge (Wooden bridge)

As you stand upon this small wooden bridge and peer into the water below, you will be able to see small fish and wild carp swimming around.



Tsubaki Road

Feel the cool air and see the camellia trees that line both sides of the course. Walk through a small path of camellia trees to find autumn leaves and a road lined with ginkgo trees. You might even see wild birds by the riverside!



Shiki no Mori

On the wooden promenade that passes through the forest running along the Isaki River, you can enjoy forest bathing while listening to the twittering of birds.



Minamo Bridge (Submerged Bridge)

A submerged bridge that crosses the Isaki River. A spot for river fun where you can experience stand-up paddle boarding from spring to autumn.
